What is Criterium Bike Racing?

- Criterium bike races are held on paved roads on a downtown course generally between 1 – 2 km in length and raced at high speeds. The roads become the Arena for the day!
- If you're a hockey or basketball spectator Criterium racing on a downtown course is like having "free" box seats to watch the races from any vantage point on the course.
- Races will include all categories from beginner to elite/pro male and female.
- A Professional Master Announcer broadcasts all day long at each event, educating the spectators on the races, introducing the top Pro's before each race and explaining the race strategies at regular intervals during the races.

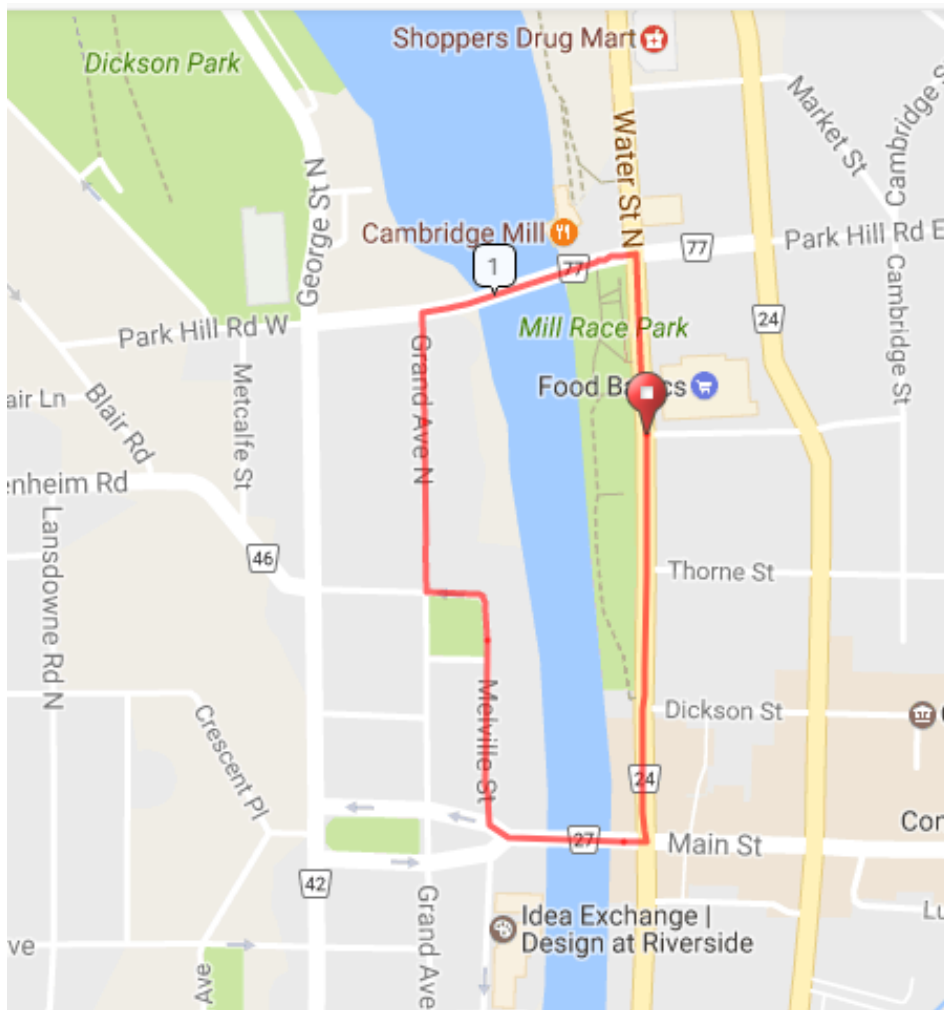

Course Map

- The Start/Finish line is located on Water St N at the corner of Thorne Street
- The race will travel south on Water Street N to Main Street
- West on Main Street over the bridge to Melville Street
- North on Melville Street to Grand Ave N
- North on Grand Ave N to Park Hill Road W
- East on Park Hill Road N over the bridge to Water St N
- South on Water St N to the finish line
- The course is a 1.3km loop with full road closure

Note: the race course will travel in a “Clockwise Direction”





Food & Beverages

- LA Franks is located at the Mill Race Park parking lot just off Water Street. Other local restaurants are located around the race course.
- Boston Pizza Food truck will be located in the Mill Race Parking lot at the south end.

Items to Bring as a Spectator

- **Spectator viewing areas** – Water St along the barricades on both sides and the Main Street bridge. Main street at Melville Street at both corners.
 - **NOTE:** please respect all the flower gardens and any residential property that you may be standing or sitting on. Please pick up all garbage that you have and dispose of it in a trash can.
- **Cowbells and clappers** are encouraged, make some noise and cheer on the racers
- **Families** are encouraged to come, bring your kids and see some great amateur and Pro racing up close and it's FREE!
- **Corners** can be great places to watch a Criterium race as racers can reach speeds upwards of 50+km/hr.
- **Races** are ability based category's
 - **NOTES:** Masters are athletes over 35, the higher the category number the faster the racers. Example: E1 Elite Pro is the Top Division, Masters 1 Top Division
- **Prime (pronounced Preem)** laps are a bell lap that the organizers decide to put into the race at any time with racers sprinting to win a lap during the race for sponsor prizes and cash. Watch for the Canadian Flag being hanged from the stage on the start finish line and announced. These Preem laps add lots of speed and excitement in the middle of the races. Gamblers Preem is when the audience all pitch in spare change/bills for the Elite Pro races to up the amount of cash!

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
